

ARCADIA NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH 2012

The Arcadia Neighborhood Association (ANA) has identified three primary areas of enforcement concern to Arcadia residents: (1) abuse of home occupancy limits, (2) speeding/parking violations, and (3) noise disturbances. One demonstrated way to meet these concerns is through collective monitoring and reporting of violations. How can we do this? NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH.

OUR MISSION

The Arcadia Neighborhood Watch has been established to monitor and report criminal activity and quality of life issues to the appropriate authorities in order to maintain a safe and enjoyable neighborhood for all residents.

WE HAVE GOALS!

- Uphold the City of Kalamazoo's single family zoning of the Arcadia Neighborhood.
- Uphold the City of Kalamazoo's Parking Requirements for single family zoning.
- Maintaining a neighborhood that is safe for children and adults to walk, run, ride and play in by monitoring speeds and keeping sidewalks and streets clear and easily accessible.
- Act as a liaison between Arcadia Neighborhood residents, Arcadia Neighborhood Association Board, Kalamazoo Department of Public Safety and City Housing Inspectors to keep all informed of activity and issues in Arcadia Neighborhood.
- Create a system of monitoring, reporting, and following up on suspicious activity and violations in the Arcadia Neighborhood.
- Create a unified neighborhood that encourages and supports each other in order to maintain the neighborhood.
- Educate Arcadia Neighborhood residents on ways to prevent and report crime as well as report quality of life issues.
